










If you click on the link, the list of **Criteria Type Codes** will appear. Highlight the **Criteria Type Code** you want and click the **Select** button.


When you select the **Criteria Type**, it will populate the **Criteria Group** area. You can select the dropdown arrow or the link to access the **Criteria Groups.**







The **Criteria Groups** will appear. You can select any of the three areas. If you click on the arrow next to the **Criteria Group**, you can view the Intervention Areas.
