## KANKAKEE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 111 BOARD OF EDUCATION PREVAILING WAGE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted, "An Act regulating the wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works project by the state, county, city or any public body, or any political subdivision, or by anyone under contract for public works projects," approved on June 26, 1941, codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1, et seq. (1993), formerly the Illinois Revised Statutes Chapter 48, par. 39s-1 et seq.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid Act requires that Kankakee School District 111, in the County of Kankakee, and the State of Illinois, to investigate and ascertain that the prevailing rates of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of Kankakee County, Illinois, employed in performing construction of public works for said School District;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the President and Board of Education of Kankakee School District 111:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by, "An Act regulating the wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works project by the state, county, city or any public body, or any political subdivision, or by anyone under contract for public works projects," approved on June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works projects coming under the jurisdiction of Kankakee School District 111, is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction in Kankakee County as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor as of June of the current year. A copy of that determination is hereby attached as Exhibit "AA" and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Illinois Department of Labor shall supersede their June 1, 2023 determination and thereby apply to any and all public works projects subsequently undertaken by Kankakee School District 111. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution which are also used in the aforesaid Act, and shall be the same as in said Act.
