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### **REQUESTS**

Requests for information under the Freedom of Information Act are to be submitted to a FOIA Officer in writing via postal mail, fax, email, or in person at the addresses listed above. No fee is charged for the first 50 pages of black and white, letter or legal sized copies. The fee for additional copies is 15 cents per page. Color copies or a size other than letter or legal will be charged the actual cost for reproducing the records.

### **FOIA OFFICE**

The FOIA Office is a function of the Office of the Superintendent. The duty of the FOIA Officer is to process public requests for information. The purpose of the Office is to provide timely and accurate responses to information requests governed by the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. There is no specific budget allocated to these responsibilities.

### **SCHOOL DISTRICT DESCRIPTION**

Kankakee School District Number 111, a "special charter" district located in Kankakee County, approximately fifty-seven (57) miles south of Chicago, encompasses forty-eight (48) square miles, was organized and effectuated pursuant to the Illinois School Code, provides a free public education from kindergarten through twelfth grade to all eligible children who reside in the City of Kankakee, the Village of Aroma Park and the farming areas east and south of the City of Kankakee. The School District has an annual budget of approximately \$67 million dollars. The School District employs around 800 full and part-time employees.
