Beginning September 8th

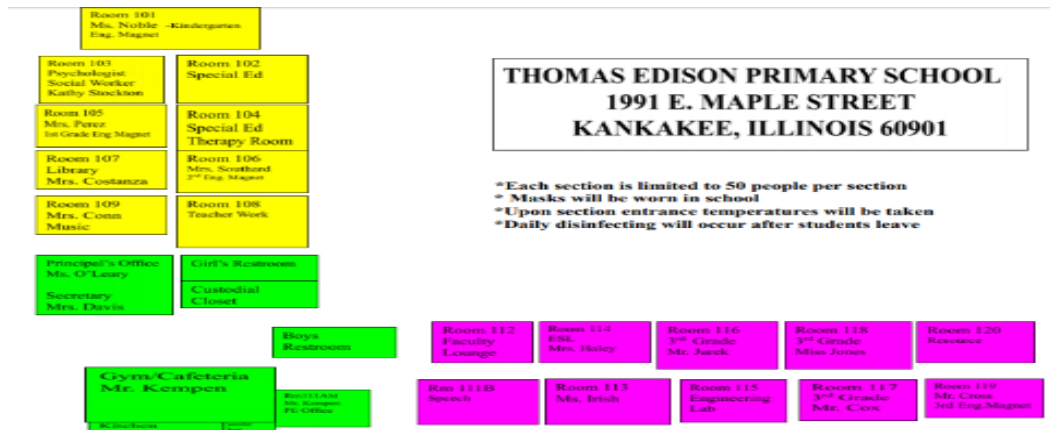
Students that are e-learners (remote) will receive their instruction virtually.
