



District Covid 19 Protocols:

Blended Flexible Learning Option:

- Students will have an opportunity to attend their chosen academy and elective classes based on their schedules (Academy in-person sessions occur once per week/electives meet every other week)
- A course catalog will be available to indicate days and times of each class offering
- A virtual tutorial will be provided to access the course catalog
- Remote instruction and support will be provided by individual teachers (times to be determined)
- Additional support will be provided to students and parents will be notified of dates and times
- All students will have an opportunity to contact teachers during their office hours (see course catalog) for individual support

Student Success Center:

The Student Success Center will have flexible hours to accommodate the needs of all students

- Childcare will be offered through other community resources

Transportation:

- Yellow buses will only be available for the 9am-12pm and 2pm-5pm Instructional sessions. All other time slots will require public transportation or other means of drop off/pick up
- Parents are encouraged to bring their child(ren) to school, drop off, or utilize public transportation (Metro) which is free of cost at this time
- Students can obtain a parking permit from the KHS Main Office
