Graduation Requirements for Class of 2022	
Content Area for Credit	Portfolios
English	4 <i>Minimum equivalent of 4 credits</i>
Mathematics	3 <i>Minimum equivalent of 3 credits Must include Algebra 1 and Geometry</i>
Science	3 <i>Minimum equivalent of 3 credits Must include Biology and 1 year of Physical Science</i>
Social Studies	2 <i>Minimum equivalent of 2 credits Must include U.S. History and American Government, passing of the U.S. Constitution exam.</i>
World Language	1 <i>Minimum equivalent of .5 credit*</i>
Consumer Education	1 <i>Minimum equivalent of .5 credit*</i>
Health/Physical Education	1 <i>Minimum equivalent 0.5 credit in Health and minimum 3.5 credits of PE or equivalent substitution or exemptions**</i>
These competencies must be completed through either a course, academy experience, or learning cycle. These portfolios are an embedded aspect of the learning experiences, not separate credits. They will be tracked on the student's transcripts.
