

## COVID-19 Protocol

### Self-Certification Symptom Screening

#### Self-certification

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, all District staff members, parents/guardians of students, under the age of 18 (on behalf of those students), and students over the age of 18 must certify **on a daily basis prior to arriving at a District property**, that they/their student do not have any of the symptoms of COVID-19 listed below:

#### Symptom Checklist

Please identify whether you have any of the following symptoms. Please focus on new or unexpected symptoms (e.g., a chronic cough would not be a positive screen).

- Fever of at least 100.4 degrees
- New cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue from unknown cause
- Muscle aches or body aches
- New onset of moderate to severe headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Vomiting or diarrhea

#### District Employees

Prior to arrival at a District property, District employees shall provide a daily self-certification as follows:

**All employees will self-certify using the Crisis Go App that they are not experiencing any of the symptoms listed in the above symptom checklist.**

If a District employee has not completed the daily self-certification prior to arrival at a District property, such employee must undergo a temperature check upon arrival at a District property and verify they are symptom-free, before being permitted entry to any District building.

#### Students

Prior to a student's arrival at a District property, parents/guardians of students under the age of 18 and students over the age of 18 shall provide a daily certification/self-certification as follows:

**Using the Crisis Go App, all parents/guardians of students under the age of 18 will certify, on behalf of their student(s), that such student(s) is not experiencing/exhibiting any of the symptoms listed in the above symptom checklist.**

**Using the Crisis Go App, all students over the age of 18 will self-certify that they are not experiencing any of the symptoms listed in the above symptom checklist.**

If a parent/guardian has not completed the daily certification prior to the student's arrival at a District property, the student must undergo a symptom screening pursuant to the District's symptom screening

protocol.

If a student over the age of 18 has not completed the daily self-certification prior to arrival at a District property, the student must undergo a symptom screening pursuant to the District's symptom screening protocol.

### **Students on Buses**

For students traveling to school on the bus, parents/guardians on behalf of their students under the age of 18 and students over the age of 18 shall provide a daily certification/self-certification prior to the student's arrival at a District property, as follows:

**Using the Crisis Go App, all parents/guardians of students under the age of 18 will certify, on behalf of their student(s), that such student(s) is not experiencing/exhibiting any of the symptoms listed in the above symptom checklist.**

**Using the Crisis Go App, all students over the age of 18 will self-certify that they are not experiencing any of the symptoms listed in the above symptom checklist.**

### **Visitors**

Visitors will be screened upon arrival at the District pursuant to the District's symptom screening protocol, as follows:

**Visitors will be asked to confirm that he/she/they do not have any of the symptoms listed on the symptoms checklist.**

**Visitors will be asked to confirm that he/she/they have not had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes over a 24-hour period) with a person known to be infected with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.**
