Special Education Evaluation

Students may be referred for a special education evaluation by school district personnel, the parents, community service agencies, persons having primary care and custody of the child, other professional persons having knowledge of the child's problems, the child, or the State Board of Education.

The evaluation procedures will be in accordance with federal and State law to determine whether a child is disabled and the nature and extent of the special education and related services the child needs.

Should a student be referred with less than 60 student attendance days left in the school year, eligibility determination for the student to receive special education services will be made before the first day of the following school year.
