- 6. Uniforms Mrs. Wells asked how the school uniforms were going. Dr. Walters said that approximately 90% of the students are in uniform. It was stated that hoodies are a problem not only at the high school but at the junior high as well and there seems to be different standards at each school. Dr. Walters also said that PE is a problem at the high school. Mrs. Johnston said it was a problem at the junior high school also. Dr. Walters stated that she sent Dr. Lambert over to the high school to observe the PE classes and is hoping that Dr. Lambert, Nancy Berkus-math consultant, and Mike Bielski, science chair, can help bring the PE Department back to where teaching is taking place.
