## Student Uniform Guidelines

#### Kankakee School District #111 school uniform consists of:

- All slacks, pants, capris, skirts, jumpers, or shorts should be a solid color khaki, black, or navy blue. Jumpers, skirts, or shorts must be just above the kneecap or longer; pleat or flat fronts are acceptable.
- All gentlemen in 4th grade through 12th grade must wear a belt. Belts should be dress type with plain buckles. Belts should be a solid color white, black, navy blue, or brown.
- Shirts and blouses should be collared, long or short sleeve knit polo, or golf shirts in a solid single color white, Columbia blue (light blue), maroon or navy blue. KHS students may also wear black collared shirts.
- Sweaters, cardigans, vests, suit jackets, and coats (when worn during the school day) should be solid single colors white, Columbia blue (light blue), or maroon. District letter jackets and District logos are allowed.
- Shoes allowed with uniforms are athletic, loafers, or dress shoes. All shoes must be closed-toed and closed heeled; fastened or tied; and must match each other. Shoes should be brown, black, white, or navy. During the summer months, sandals may be worn as long as they have a strap on the back. No flip-flops are allowed.
